CRITERIA: The major emphasis in the selection of a recipient for the MERIT AWARDS will be placed upon demonstrated excellence in one or more areas of leadership, scholarship, talent and athletics. Additional evaluations will be based on other extracurricular activities, dedication to Sigma Nu's ideals, contribution to the progress and development of the chapter, school, Fraternity, state and nation.

ELIGIBILITY: Applicants should be a Brother in college in good standing who has been active in his chapter and whose personal traits, demonstrated leadership, scholarship, talent, athletic achievement and fraternity service mark him as one who has contributed to the excellence of Sigma Nu at his college or university.
