DAVID C. RUEGG INDUCTED INTO THE SIGMA NU HALL OF HONOR

Lexington, Va. – Sigma Nu Fraternity, Inc., is pleased to announce that David C. Ruegg was inducted into the Sigma Nu Hall of Honor on July 18, 2006, in Indianapolis, Ind., during the 62nd Grand Chapter (Convention). The Hall of Honor is the highest recognition the Fraternity can bestow on an alumnus.

Over Sigma Nu's 137-year history, only 73 alumni have been inducted into the Hall of Honor. Each inductee must have not only distinguished himself in his respective field, but also rendered distinctive service to the progress and well-being of Sigma Nu Fraternity.

David C. Ruegg, a native of the Berkeley, Calif., area, was initiated into the Beta Psi Chapter at the University of California Berkeley in 1959. His dedicated service to the General Fraternity began in 1968 when he took on the roles of Beta Psi Chapter Advisor and Treasurer – a position he held for 20 years. In 1984 he served as the Division Commander for chapters in California. In 1992, he became the Fraternity's 53rd Regent (National President), the highest office within the Fraternity. Since 2002, Brother Ruegg has served as a Director for the Sigma Nu Educational Foundation and is currently a member of the Foundation's Executive Committee. He is also the Vice President of Rue-Ell Enterprises, Inc. located in Berkeley, Calif.

Sigma Nu Fraternity, Inc. is an international men's fraternity founded in 1869 at Virginia Military Institute. Headquartered in Lexington, Va., Sigma Nu Fraternity has chapters and colonies on college campuses throughout the United States and Canada.
