

Sigma Nu Chapter Notice on COVID-19 Risks Personal Responsibility and Assumption of Risk

According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (“CDC”) at CDC.gov the COVID-19 virus is thought to spread mainly from person-to-person between people who are in close contact with one another (within about 6 feet) through respiratory droplets produced when an infected person coughs, sneezes, or talks.

PROTECTING YOURSELF AND OTHERS INVOLVES CONTINUAL PERSONAL DECISIONS AND ACTIONS – YOUR DECISIONS AND ACTIONS.

The information available at CDC.gov provides:

STAY HOME IF YOU DO NOT FEEL WELL OR IF YOU TESTED POSITIVE FOR COVID-19 OR IF YOU WERE EXPOSED TO SOMEONE WITH COVID-19 WITHIN THE LAST 14 DAYS

STAY 6 FEET AWAY FROM PEOPLE

AVOID SHARING ITEMS WITH OTHERS

WEAR A CLOTH FACE COVERING

WASH YOUR HANDS OFTEN FOR AT LEAST 20 SECONDS with soap and water

COVER YOUR COUGHS AND SNEEZES
