- **Qualifications-** education, professional standards, associations,
- **Staffing Models-** entry to senior levels, independent vs. collective, reporting
- **Public vs. Private Campus-** system requirements
- **Housing Model-** university or college owned vs. private
- **Size and Scope-** types of councils and organizations

- **Student Safety & Conduct-** multiple layered

- **Community Building-** overall, council, level, general
- **Recruitment/Intake-** structures
