LEAD Award Categories

EXCELLENCE IN LEAD

These awards recognize chapters that excel in their use of an individual phase of the program.

Awards are given for each phase – Phase I: The Way of Honor, Phase II: The Life of Love, Phase III: The Light of Truth, Phase IV: The End...The Beginning, and All-Chapter. Multiple chapters may be recognized in each phase and a chapter is eligible to win awards in every phase.

*These awards will be determined based on information provided in the chapter's annual Pursuit of Excellence Program chapter self-assessment submission. No separate application form is required to be considered for the "Excellence in..." awards.

INNOVATION IN LEAD

This award recognizes the chapter(s) that display innovation in their adaptation and expansion of parts of the program through new, exciting, and creative ways to engage their Brothers in the LEAD Program. **Complete the following form to apply.**
